HEALTHCARE TRUSTEES OF NEW YORK STATE ELECTS 2007 OFFICERS AND NEW BOARD MEMBERS

ALBANY, N.Y.—The Board of Governors of the Healthcare Trustees of New York State (HTNYS) has elected its 2007 chairman, officers, and board members. HTNYS is a not-for-profit membership organization dedicated to strengthening the governance of New York's non-profit and public health care facilities. HTNYS is governed by a board of 25 trustees from health care facilities across the state and is an affiliate of the Healthcare Association of New York State.

Steven L. Albertalli, a trustee and past president of the Board of Directors of Corning Hospital, was re-elected Chairman of the HTNYS Board, effective January 1.

The Board elected the following officers to serve one-year terms:

The Board also elected two new board members to serve three-year terms beginning January 1: **Charles S. Ryan, J.D., Ph.D.** and **Richard J. Sullivan, Jr.** Dr. Ryan serves as the Chairman of the Advisory Council at Stony Brook University Medical Center and Mr. Sullivan is Chairman of the Board of Catholic Health Services of Long Island.
