

WHAT'S CHIA?

Since 1997, HANYS' Community Health Improvement Award has honored hospitals and health systems for their outstanding initiatives aimed at improving the health and well-being of communities. The award recognizes programs that target specific community health needs while emphasizing the importance of health equity, demonstrate leadership and collaboration with diverse community partners and achieve quantifiable results.

The winning facility will be recognized in person at HANYS' Annual Membership Conference June 24-26 and promoted through a video celebrating your program, produced by HANYS.

All submissions that meet award criteria will be included in HANYS' <u>Community Health Initiatives Tool</u> and <u>annual profile book</u>. Members and their community partners are encouraged to use these resources for inspiration and direction on how to replicate successful programs in their own communities.

CHIA INITIATIVES

- ☑ are community-focused, to identify and address the health needs of the community;
- ☑ use a collaborative approach, working with community partners;
- □ are preventive, not part of acute care and usually taking place outside of a clinic or hospital; and
- ☑ are related to the New York State *Prevention Agenda* that aims to improve the health status of individuals in New York and reduce disparities through a strong emphasis on prevention.

CHIA INITIATIVES ARE NOT

☑ quality improvement, patient safety, care transition or inpatient-focused.

WINNER SELECTION

Submissions are judged by an external panel of experts on the following criteria:

Background and <i>Prevention Agenda</i> priority	15 points
Collaboration and approach	30 points
Results and impact on the community	35 points
Conclusions and sustainability	20 points

The submission scoring the highest will be awarded.
