
ADE rate






Drug category ADE rates


Anticoagulant ADE



Insulin ADE




Opioid ADE

Medicare FFS data only: Discharged home on 90 MME or more of Morphine per day






Medicare FFS data only: Co-occurring benzo and opioid prescribed at discharge






Medicare FFS data only: Two or more opioids ordered at discharge






Severe hypoglycemia HAC










Overall CAUTI rate






Overall CLABSI rate






Falls with any harm





Pressure injuries stage II and greater






PSI 3: PI Stage III and greater






Medicare readmission

Sepsis mortality rate




